

Come and enjoy the many beautiful parks in Oak Bay!

Anderson Hill Lovely park to walk and enjoy ocean views overlooking Trial Island and the Strait of Juan de Fuca.

Carnarvon Park Six outdoor tennis courts, sports fields and the home of Oak Bay Lawn Bowling Club and the Rotary Water Park. The Water Park opens May long weekend and is open May-June (11am to 4pm weekends only), and July to September - 10am to 6pm daily.

Cattle Point Two boat launches and great views of Mt. Baker.

Firemen's Park Sports field and a playground.

Gyro Park Playground and greenspace.

Henderson Park Home of Henderson Recreation Centre, 6 outdoor tennis courts (3 lit, 3 unlit), sports fields, playground, 1km chip trail with a fitness circuit around the nine hole par 3 golf course.

Native Plant Garden Stroll around garden and pond areas which acts as a preserve for plants indigenous to southern Vancouver Island.

Uplands Park 76 acre park with a number of trails to explore and an excellent example of a Garry Oak meadow. Uplands Park is also home to a number of rare plant species.

Willows Beach Park The jewel of Oak Bay with its sandy beach, esplanade, playground and is home of the Kiwanis Tea Room. The Tea Room is open 9am to 5pm daily from the last week in April until the last week in September.

Windsor Park Home of Windsor Pavilion, sports fields, accessible playground, 4 outdoor tennis courts.

Trees on your Property ~ Oak Bay's Tree Preservation Bylaw

The purpose of this bylaw is to help reduce the number of trees damaged or removed and to encourage the replanting of trees on private property. Even though a tree is on private property, the entire neighbourhood benefits from its presence and it is an invaluable asset. Trees reflect the natural heritage of the community and provide immeasurable environmental benefits. They clean and filter air, buffer and screen noise, provide catchments for rain water, attract wildlife and reduce heat during the summer. The Tree Bylaw is available at www.oakbay.ca.

- Dogs are not permitted on any portion of Windsor Park that has been reserved by evidence of a permit issued under the authority of the Oak Bay Parks and Recreation Commission.

Willows Beach

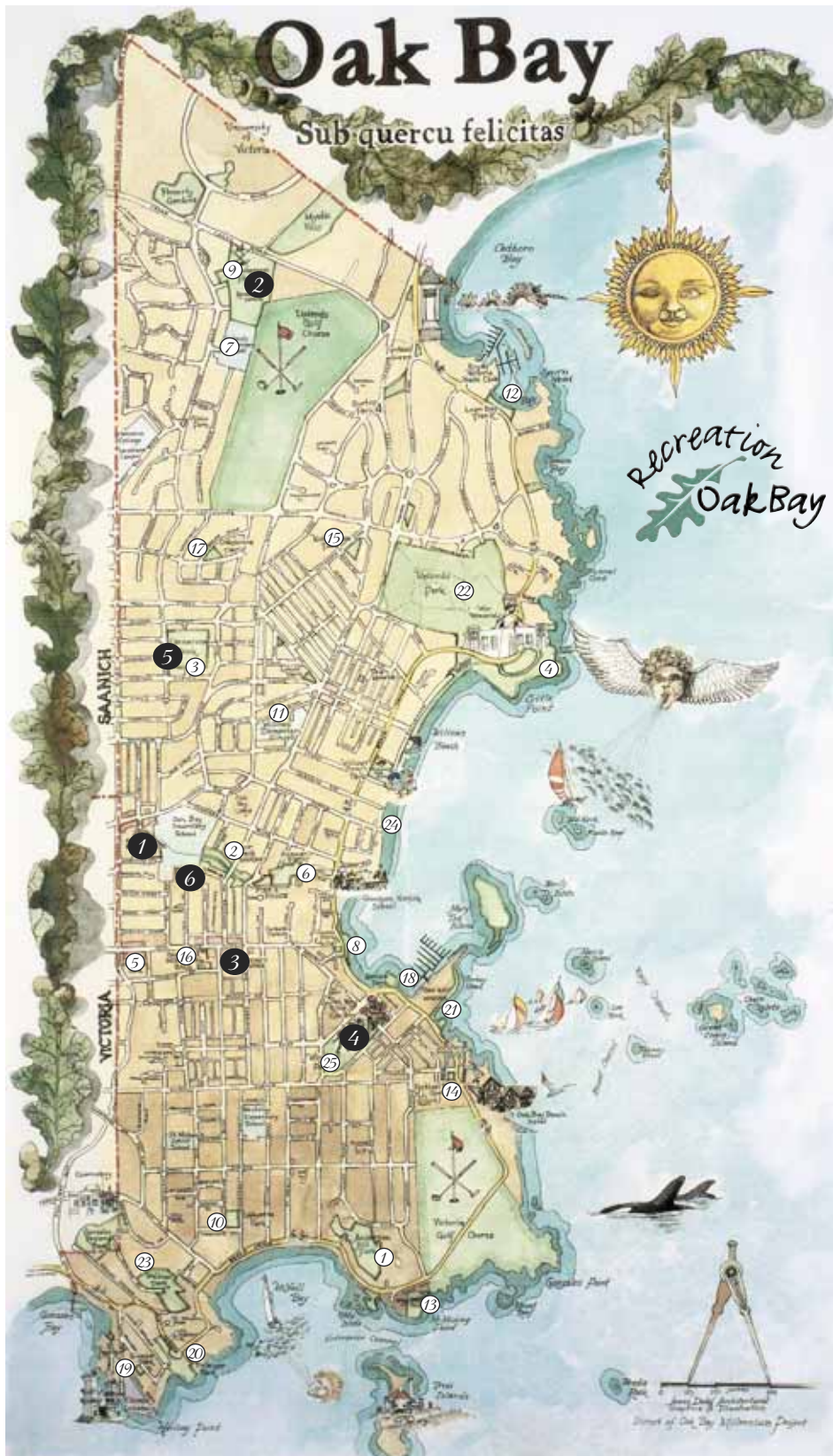
- Between October 1st and April 30th only.

McNeill Bay

- October 1st thru April 30th.
- Sunrise to 11am - May through September.
- 7pm to sunset - May through September.

- Off-leash during: January, February, March, July, August, September, October, November & December.
- Under full control of a competent person: April, May and June.
